Call to Celebrate: Baptism Suggested Format for a One-Day, Two-Hour Session

Before the Session

In advance of the session, ask participants to:

- Read the Godparent Information Sheet, p. 41.
- Reflect upon and complete the "Spiritual Hopes and Dreams" activity sheet, p. 7 of the Parent Handbook.
- Reflect upon and complete the "Original Sin" activity, pp. 8–9 of the Parent Handbook.

 Communion of Saints information and prayer (pp. 55–56)

Invite parents to share general non-spiritual hopes and dreams they have for their child. Record responses on newsprint. invite parents to share the spiritual hopes and dreams they have for their child as they recorded on the activity sheet before coming to the session. Summarize responses on newsprint, noting common themes. Share with parents your own response to the question "What do you ask of God's Church for your chid?" Encourage parents to continue discussing this topic in the days ahead.
